• MATURE PLANTS

Mix **3** ounces of The Magnificent Garden Multi-Purpose Plant Food with 1 gallon of water for mature plants. This balanced ratio provides the necessary nutrients for sustaining and promoting healthy growth in fully developed plants.

• STARTER PLANTS

For young starter plants, dilute The Magnificent Garden Multi-Purpose Plant Food at a rate of **2** ounces per gallon of water.

This gentler concentration provides a nurturing boost to help seedlings and young plants establish strong roots and early growth.

• SEEDLINGS

For delicate seedlings, dilute The Magnificent Garden Multi-Purpose Plant Food at a rate of **.50** ounces per gallon of water. This mild solution ensures gentle nourishment for vulnerable seedlings, allowing them to develop sturdy stems and healthy foliage.

Follow Recommended Application Rates:

Delicate seedlings benefit from a milder approach. Apply once every 3-4 weeks

Starter Plants:

Every 2 weeks
